



N = 5182 households (ADP)


#### INCLUSION CRITERIA:

- ADP composed by at least one heterosexual couple
  - Married/Cohabiting
  - With (or without) dependent children
  - Living (or not) with other adults
- ADP with income
- ADP's income managed by at least one member of the couple
- N = 3331 ADPs



#### Estatuto da Relação










