## **Introduction**

NUK welcomes students who are currently enrolled at a university with which NUK has a valid student exchange agreement and are officially nominated by their home university.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants can apply for entering exchange student program according to the requirements of their home university. Please contact the institution of your home university for application details.

Applications should be submitted via your university's institution in charge. Please do not send your applications directly to NUK.

## **Time and Term of Exchange Program**

**Applicants may choose to study for one semester or two semesters starting from September, 2026.**

- ◎ Fall Semester 2026 : September, 2026-January, 2027
  
- ◎ Spring Semester 2027 : February, 2027- June, 2027

## **Housing**

Not all exchange students are guaranteed to stay at the campus dorm. If students want to live in the student dormitory, they must apply for accommodation.

### **【About NUK Student Dorm】**

-Accommodation Fee : NT\$8,000~NT\$10,000 per semester (bedding and

electricity fee excluded).

- Each student will share a room with 3 roommates, including Taiwanese students.
- Students must pay a deposit of NT\$2,000, which will be refunded while checking out the dorm.
- Students need to do the online application for the dorm after they're officially accepted as NUK's incoming exchange students, and if they fail to apply for the dorm, they have to search for off-campus accommodation.

## How to Apply

To apply for entering international exchange program :

- STEP (1) Applicants must prepare all required documents (including application forms and related documents) and submit all required documents to home university's coordinators.
- STEP (2) Coordinators need to review all required documents and then send the scanned documents (including application forms and related documents) by e-mail to [ting79015@nuk.edu.tw](mailto:ting79015@nuk.edu.tw).
- STEP (3) Coordinators need to post the originals of all required documents (including application forms and related documents) to our dean office by EMS before submission deadline.


