

The Trans-National History of the Great War (August 26th-29th) Jay Winter

Jay Winter is the Charles J. Stille Professor of History Emeritus at Yale University. He is a specialist on World War I and its impact on the 20th century. Winter was also the co-producer, co-writer, and chief historian for the PBS/BBC series "the Great War and the Shaping of the 20th Century", which won an Emmy Award, a Peabody Award and a Producers Guild of America Award for the best television documentary in 1997. He has received honorary doctorates

from the University of Graz, the University of Leuven, and the University of Paris.



Science and Society in Modern China (June 26th-30th) Eugenia Lean

Professor Eugenia Lean is a scholar of modern Chinese history, with special regard to history of science, technology and industry. She received her BA from Stanford (1990) and her MA and PhD (1996, 2001) from the University of California, Los Angeles. Before joining the Columbia faculty in 2002, she taught at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. She was featured in "Top Young Historians" of the History News Network (fall 2008) and

received the 2013-2014 Faculty Mentoring Award for faculty in Columbia's

Graduate School of Arts and Sciences. She is currently the Director of the Weatherhead East Asian Institute.


Pablo A. Blitstein

Dr. Pablo A. Blitstein is an Associate Professor at the School of Advanced Studies in the Social Sciences (Ecole des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales), Paris. He conducts research on both medieval and late imperial China, as well as on global networks of Chinese reformers in the late 19th


and early 20th century. His research interests lie in global and intellectual history, with a particular focus on writing practices and political institutions. He obtained his PhD at the National Institute of Oriental Languages and Civilizations in 2012. Prior to joining the School of Advanced Studies in Social Sciences, he worked as a research assistant at the Collège de France, a researcher at the Cluster of Excellence "Asia and Europe in a Global Context" and a lecturer at Heidelberg University .His research themes include the history of nationalism between East Asia, Europe, and the Americas in the 19th and 20th centuries, the history of knowledge and political institutions in 19th-early 20th century China, and the history of early medieval China.

- 2) Please upload a photo taken in the past six months.
- 3) Please fill in all the blanks marked with red asterisk on the form. If the applicant does not have a Chinese name, please input "no".
- 4) Before submission, the applicant needs to upload the digitalized copy of various documents, including:
 - A. Passport photo page: the passport should remain valid in the upcoming 6 months. If the passport expires during the period of study, please renew the passport before filling out the application form; otherwise, students need to request for a new DQ form to apply Chinese visa. This will take extra weeks.
 - B. Personal photo
 - C. Transcript: must be in English or Chinese
 - D. One letter of recommendation or reference letter: must be a letter from either the international office of the home institution or the home department of the student.
 - E. CV

- *Applicants from non-English teaching schools shall provide proof of proficiency in English, such as scores of TOEFL, GRE, IELTS, or CET 4/CET 6.
- 5) After submission, the applicant needs to print out and sign the form.
- 4. Please bring and submit the hard copies of documents to the teaching assistant when the applicant takes the first class. Here is the **check list**:
 - 1) Printed application form, with photo and signature
 - 2) Photocopy of the passport photo page
 - 3) Transcript
 - 4) CV
 - 5) Letter of recommendation
 - 6) Copy of certificate of language proficiency (Chinese or English, if applicable)




