Epilogue: a bedtime story for archaeologists

Once upon a time, 9,000 years ago in the Belgian Campine, a group of hunter-gatherers had established their camp on an old sand dune that rose above an area of marshes and woods. One day, a member of this group, a right-hander, walked a little way away from his habitation, built a fire, sat down beside it and began to make some tools. Some of these tools he made from blanks he had brought with him. He also brought along some cobbles of flint on which he prepared some platforms and struck from them a number of blanks which he retouched into tools. Using all of these tools, he began boring, graving and scraping bone and antler. While he was at work another member of the group, a left-hander, sat down beside him next to the fire. This left hander had brought with him a previously prepared core from which he now struck several elegant blanks and retouched them into tools. He also began boring and graving bone. After working for some time the left-hander departed, taking his core with him. The right-hander also left, taking with him a few tools, some blanks and one prepared core. He walked back to his habitation perhaps because the light had failed, or perhaps because supper was ready and the family was waiting (or not waiting). There in due course he gave his bone objects their finishing touches and decoration.
